# A Cracking Good Time!

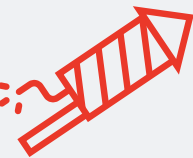
What an amazing night Post 16 (and staff) had at the formal at Stormont. Everyone looked fabulous and had a great night singing and dancing.
